You will be required to support the project manager and support team by reaching out to local people and offering advice and support. You will get support from a warm welcoming team.

- Support in running events and workshops about energy saving and staying warm.
- Speak to local people to understand how they need help and encourage them to join our programs.

- Assist with home visits to offer advice on saving energy and managing energy bills.
- Help give out leaflets and flyers to raise awareness.
- Work with other volunteers and local organizations to help people in your area.
