A new Lidl for Hamsey Green, Warlingham



Lidl GB is preparing a planning application to deliver a new Lidl store on land off Tithepit Shaw Lane and Limpsfield Road in Hamsey Green, Warlingham. A new Lidl store on this site would increase local shopping choice and create up to 40 new local jobs. Six new 3-bed townhouses are proposed, along with seven 2 and 3-bed apartments above the Lidl store. The plans represent a multi-million pound investment and will regenerate this currently disused site.

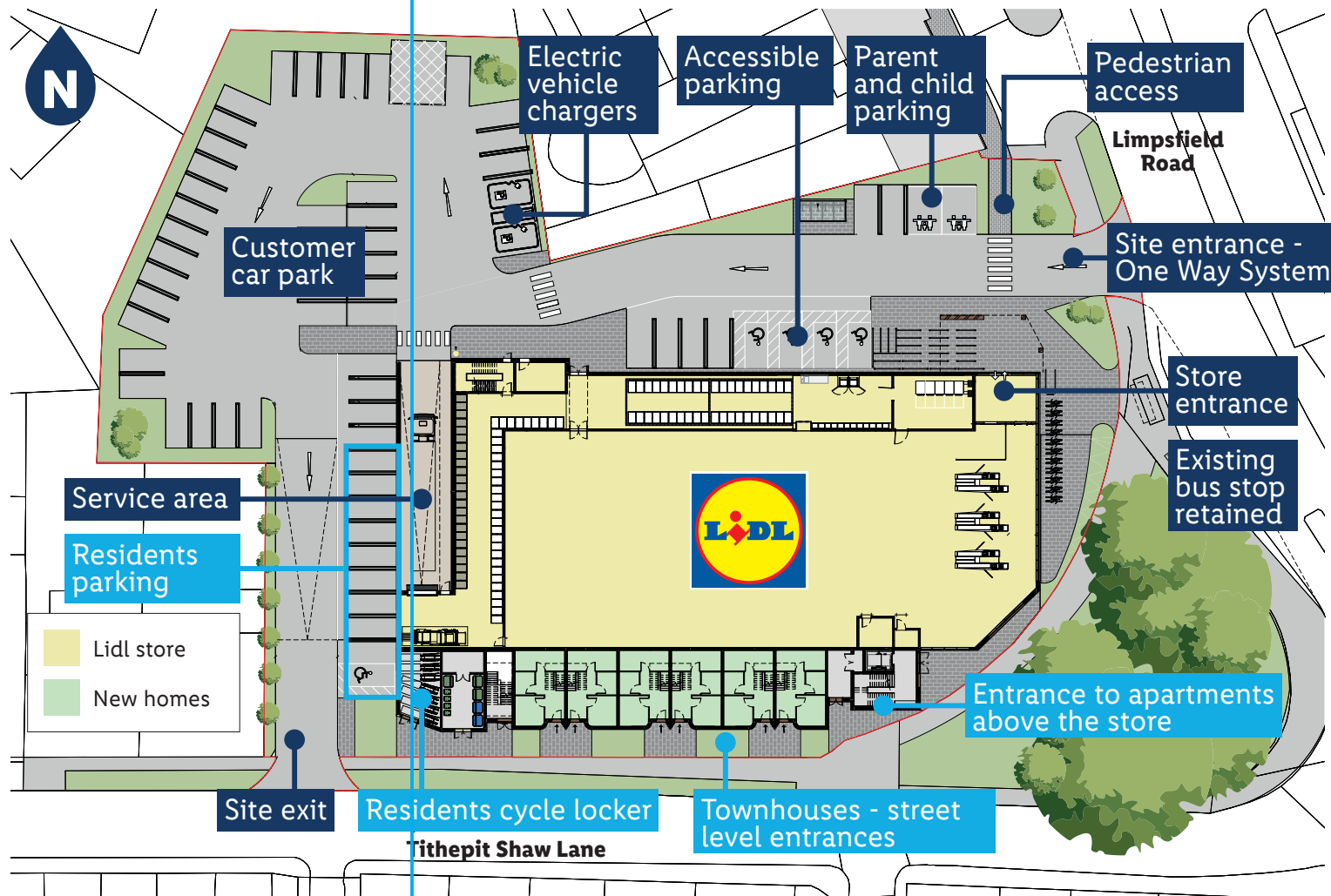


A new landscaping scheme will propose new planting to enhance the site
